Kansas needs some political changes in our community. Here is how you can help make these changes our community needs. You can **register and vote**. Then ask 20 of your friends, neighbors and family to **PLEASE** register and **VOTE** on **Tuesday, November 3, 2020** at the General Election. Here are five tips to help make changes in our community:

- Plan ahead to make sure your vote is counted (Complete an Advance Ballot Application)
- Take someone to an Election office to register
- Allow a sign to be placed in your yard that impacts your interest (Candidate Supporting change)
- Attend your local City Council meetings (your interest and voice matter)
- Research your candidate prior to voting and polling location



VOTING DEADLINES

Mark your calendar of upcoming registration and voting deadlines:

- **Register to vote by October 13th**
- **Advance voting by mail October 14th and Early Voting Starts October 20, 2020**
- **Vote in Person on 10/24 & 10/31 in Wyandotte County at Eisenhower Middle School and Argentine Polling locations from 10am-4pm. There are several locations in Johnson County.**
- **Last day to mail advance ballot application from your election office is October 27, 2020**
- **Vote in person by noon on Monday, November 2, 2020 at the Election Offices**
